ANNUAL REPORT 2019 - 20

The academic session 2019-21 session started with orientation of the batch in August 2019.

With only twenty three students admitted for the B Ed course this was a difficult year for the college. Infrastructure to be maintained, teachers and staff to be paid but, no revenue generation....only empty classrooms. All private colleges of Kolhan University had to survive somehow during this crisis period. College had to function anyhow. We had to organise events with fervour and conduct exams with full preparation. Syllabus had to be completed without compromising on the quality of education.

Orientation Day
