## MOU

### (MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING)

#### Name of the Party

**MBNS Institute of Education – First Party**

**And**

**D.B.M.S. College of Education– Second Party**

#### Objective

The Parties agree that the objective of this MoU (hereinafter referred to as "the Objective") is to set up the general principles of collaboration between both Parties, according to which the Parties may jointly identify fields of mutual interest and create opportunities to develop programmes for cooperation and rural development , various areas of management in training, education and other knowledge -based activities on the basis of reciprocity and mutual benefit and also to facilitate building cadres of professional managers to man key positions in the ever growing number of co-operatives through management development, training, education, research and consultancy

#### Area / Scope of Cooperation

##### 1. Related to Research / Research Publication

1. Organise Seminars/Workshops as well as consultations on regular basis and come up with joint publications of conference volumes and books.
2. Organise academic enhancement programmes, specially addressing research needs of young scholars and students.
3. Engagement in exchange and sharing of scholars and resources for the benefit of the greater academic community.
4. To design effective research internship programmes for students to offer field based and first-hand research experiences in relevant area of interest.
5. Engagement in joint research projects depending on mutual areas of interest between the faculties of both the institutions



6. Arrange special lectures jointly by scholars of national and international repute on annual basis.
7. To make every effort to support and promote long term teaching-research linkage between the two institutions.

## 2. Related to Faculty / Students Exchange

1. The exchange of faculty to the mutual benefit of both institutions.
2. Collaboration in teaching, research and consultancy studies in the field of mutual interest.
3. The exchange of academic material and publication.
4. Faculty collaboration for the purposes of curriculum development and review, attending of programmes, upgrading of teaching and research skill.
5. For participating in seminars, symposiums and others types of academic discussions.
6. Exchange students will be selected by mutual agreement between the home institution and host institution.
7. The host institution will evaluate an exchange student's performance in each course or module, award a letter grade or marks, and issues a letter to that effect.
8. If an exchange student has undertaken research, then the host institution will evaluate the research performance and issues a letter to that effect, together with a technical "report" of the research carried out.
9. If an exchange student has undertaken research, then the home institution will take note of the performance evaluation and the technical report and take steps in accordance with its own procedures.
10. To avail travel expenses, students can apply for existing funding programs at their respective home institution.

## 3. Cultural and sports

This can involve partnerships, sponsorship, event hosting, or other collaborative efforts.





**4. Consideration of mutual promises set forth in this MOU, the parties hereto agree as follows**

**Clause 1**

1. Both the Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations. The parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
2. The co-operation between First party and Second party will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the Second party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching /training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the First party.

**Clause 2**

1. Both the parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be a major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
2. The Second party will give valuable inputs to the First party in teaching/ training methodology so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.
3. The Second party will train the students of the First Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the gap in skill and make them ready for industry.
4. The Second party will actively engage to help the delivery of the training and placement of the students of the First Party into internships/ Jobs.



## 5. Financial Agreement

1. Any agreement under this MOU is subject to the availability of funding sources and approval by relevant authorities.
2. Any specific project of joint interest will be detailed in a separate agreement, including financial and program specific arrangements.
3. Both parties understand that all financial arrangement will have to be discussed and will depends on the availability of funds.
4. Outline the financial commitments of each party, including budget allocations, sponsorships, and any other funding sources.

## 6. Intellectual Property Right

1. Each party shall protect within its territory, intellectual property rights of the other party in accordance with the domestic law in force in their respective countries.
2. In case of specific arrangement, programs or projects that may result in intellectual property, the Parties shall conclude separate arrangement in accordance with their respective laws regulation.

## 7. Confidentiality

In the event that party wishes to disclose any data and or information supplied in or resulted from the implementation of this MOU, the disclosing Party shall have prior written consent from the other Party.

## 8. Validity

The Memorandum shall remain in force for a period of Two years commencing from effective date. Institution may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.





## 9. Termination

1. The MoU Shall be effective for Two years from the date of written consent of the party.
2. The termination of the MOU shall not affect the in completion of any projects and programs in progress and not completed at the time of the termination.
3. Either Party may terminate this MOU at any time by giving written notification to the other Party on this intention to terminate this MOU, 30 Days prior to the date of the termination.

## 10. Settlements of Disputes

In order to settle any doubts that may arise under the performance or in the construction of this MOU, the parties shall exert their best effort to reach a solution by mutual consent. In the event such consent is found to be impossible, the parties shall jointly appoint a third-party natural person, to act as mediator.

## 11. Amendment

1. This MOU may be amended or revised at any time by mutual written consent of the parties, and such amendment shall form an integral part of this MOU.
2. Such amendment or revision shall come into force on the date as may determine by the Parties.

## 12. Adjudication

Any Dispute relating to this MoU, shall be subject to jurisdiction of Civil Court, Jamshedpur, Jharkhand only.
