Drawing from his experience, Mr. Chandrashekhar highlighted key developments and policy measures, helping participants grasp both the immediate and long-term impacts of the budget. The session was highly engaging, with active participation from the audience. Questions were welcomed with enthusiasm, and the speaker addressed all queries with clarity, making the discussion both informative and interactive.

## ***Key Highlights of the Session***

- The budget focuses on strengthening the economy by increasing investments in infrastructure, education, and health.
- Considered agriculture as the 1<sup>st</sup> engine for the development - Mission for Atmanirbhar in Pulses, Kisan Dhan Jan Yojna, Makhana Board of Bihar, National Mission on High-Yielding Seeds, Enhanced Credit through KCC.
- MSME as the 2<sup>nd</sup> engine for development - Credit Cards for Micro Enterprises, New incentives have been introduced for start-ups and small businesses to encourage entrepreneurship, along with GST simplification to ease compliance for businesses, Scheme for First-time Entrepreneurs (women, SC & ST), Manufacturing Mission - Furthering “Make in India”
- Investment as the 3<sup>rd</sup> engine for development - Saksham Anganwadi and Poshan 2.0, Atal Tinkering Labs, Broadband Connectivity to Government Secondary Schools and Primary Health Care Centres, Skill Development Centre, the budget includes more allocation for higher education and research institutions, Expansion of Capacity in IITs, Expansion of medical education
- Greater investment in rural infrastructure like roads and irrigation projects.

- More focus has been given to renewable energy projects like solar and wind power.
- The government has expanded healthcare schemes to cover more people, with special provisions for senior citizens and differently-abled individuals.
- A special focus has been given to regional connectivity through the UDAAN scheme.
- Promotion of exports as the 4<sup>th</sup> engine of development, Bharat Trade Net
- Foreign Direct Investment in the Insurance Sector
- Income-tax slabs, providing relief to middle-class taxpayers.

## **LEARNING OUTCOMES**

Through this session, students gained a meaningful understanding of the Union Budget 2025. They developed insights into the crucial role the budget plays in shaping the vision for *Viksit Bharat*. **जमशेदपुर:** डीबीएमएस कॉलेज सभागार में आज बजट पर परिचर्चा का आयोजन हुआ। इस दौरान डीबीएमएस के अध्यक्ष और डीबीएमएस के स्टूडेंट के चेयरपर्सन बी.चंद्रशेखर ने शिक्षकों और छात्रों के बीच बजट 2025 के विषय में वित्तार से चर्चा की। उन्होंने बीएड के छात्रों को संबोधित करते हुए बताया कि जीडीपी किन परिस्थितियों में बढ़ता है और प्रति व्यक्ति आय से इसका क्या संबंध है। उन्होंने कहा की आज विश्व में सबसे बड़े इकानांगी में अमेरिका प्रथम स्थान पर है और भारत पांचवें स्थान पर है, लेकिन 2030 तक पांच ट्रिलियन का लक्ष्य इस बार दिया गया है। बी.चंद्रशेखर ने दो तरह के संरचना की चर्चा करते हुए कहा कि सामाजिक और आर्थिक संरचनाओं से भी जीडीपी बढ़ता है। आज भारत में 50 हवाई अड्डे हैं, लेकिन 130 हवाई अड्डा का बजट बनाया गया है,
