### **CONTEXT**

In celebration of World Environment Day 2025, the Eco Club of D.B.M.S. College of Education organized a thought-provoking webinar to raise awareness about digital activism and sustainability. The resource person for the event was Mr. Vishal Mangaraj, a research scholar and a practicing minimalist, who presented on the theme "YouTube's Green Wave: Creators Driving Sustainable Change." The session highlighted how new-age content creators are becoming environmental educators through accessible and engaging online platforms. The session was conducted through google meet.

### **OBJECTIVES**

1. To highlight the role of digital platforms like YouTube in spreading environmental awareness.
2. To showcase the influence of eco-conscious content creators on youth behaviour and sustainable habits.
3. To introduce minimalism as a practical lifestyle approach toward sustainability.
4. To encourage students to explore digital tools for environmental advocacy.



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## **PROCESS**

### **SESSION 1: 5 P.M. – 6 P.M.**

The session began with a melodious and thought-provoking poem recited by Ms. Prabha Kiran, which captured the essence of nature and the urgent need for its preservation. Her heartfelt words created a strong emotional connection and set a reflective tone for the event.

Following this, Mr. Vishal Kumar delivered an insightful speech on the significance of World Environment Day. He highlighted the historical background of the day, its global importance, and the necessity of collective action to tackle environmental issues.

Next, Ms. Priyanka Kumari addressed the audience with an engaging talk on Sustainable Living. She emphasized practical ways to adopt eco-friendly habits in everyday life and encouraged students to become responsible environmental stewards.

The session concluded with a valuable message from Dr. Monika Uppal, Vice Principal of the institution. She stressed the importance of environmental protection and urged everyone to contribute meaningfully to environmental conservation efforts at personal and community levels.

### **SESSION 2: 6:10 P.M.- 7:00 P.M.**

The 2<sup>nd</sup> session began with a brief introduction of the guest speaker, Mr. Vishal Mangaraj by Reema. In his session, he skilfully interwove research insights with inspiring real-life examples of YouTube influencers who are changing the sustainability narrative.



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He spotlighted:

- Anuj Ramatri, who promotes sustainable lifestyle alternatives through informative DIY content.
- Damanjot Kour, known for her creative upcycling projects and nature-friendly routines.
- Shweta Kataria, who blends education with ecology to teach mindful living.

Mr. Mangaraj further delved into his own lifestyle of minimalism, explaining how reducing material consumption can significantly cut down ecological footprints. The webinar concluded with a lively Q&A session, where students interacted enthusiastically with the speaker.

**Principal, Dr. Joohi Samarpita**, who spoke on the **degradation of the environment and its impact on human life**. She discussed how pollution, deforestation, and climate change are leading to serious consequences such as health issues, natural disasters, and loss of biodiversity. She urged everyone to act with urgency and commitment to reverse the damage and build a sustainable future.

As the session drew to a close, **Ms. Mousumi Dutta**, Eco Club Moderator, delivered the **final address**, summarizing the spirit of the day's discussions. She articulated the **vision and mission of the Eco Club**, highlighting its commitment to cultivating environmental consciousness and responsibility among students.

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
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


