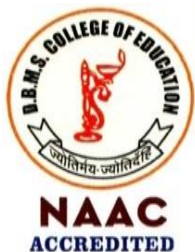

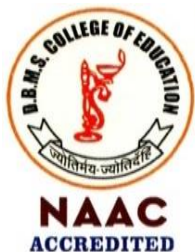
OBJECTIVE

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DAY 1 (18TH NOVEMBER 2024)

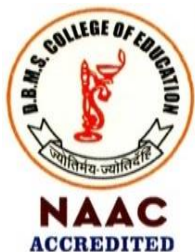

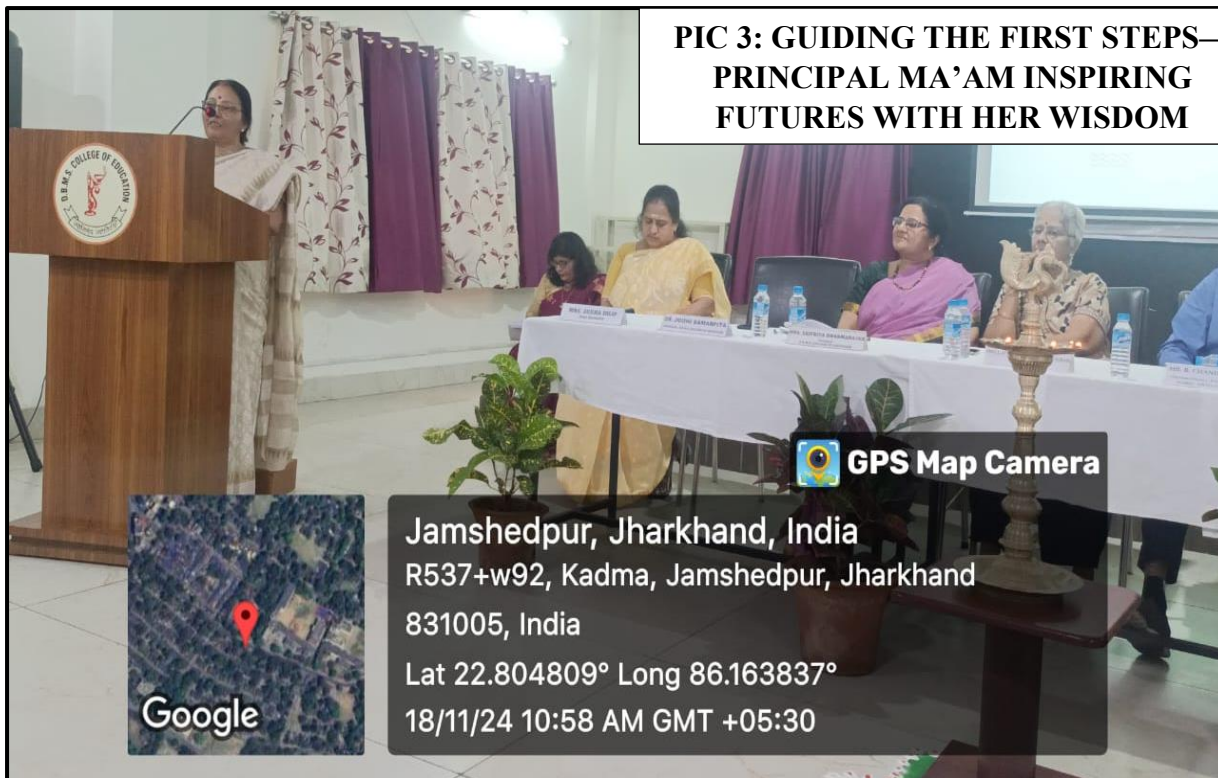
