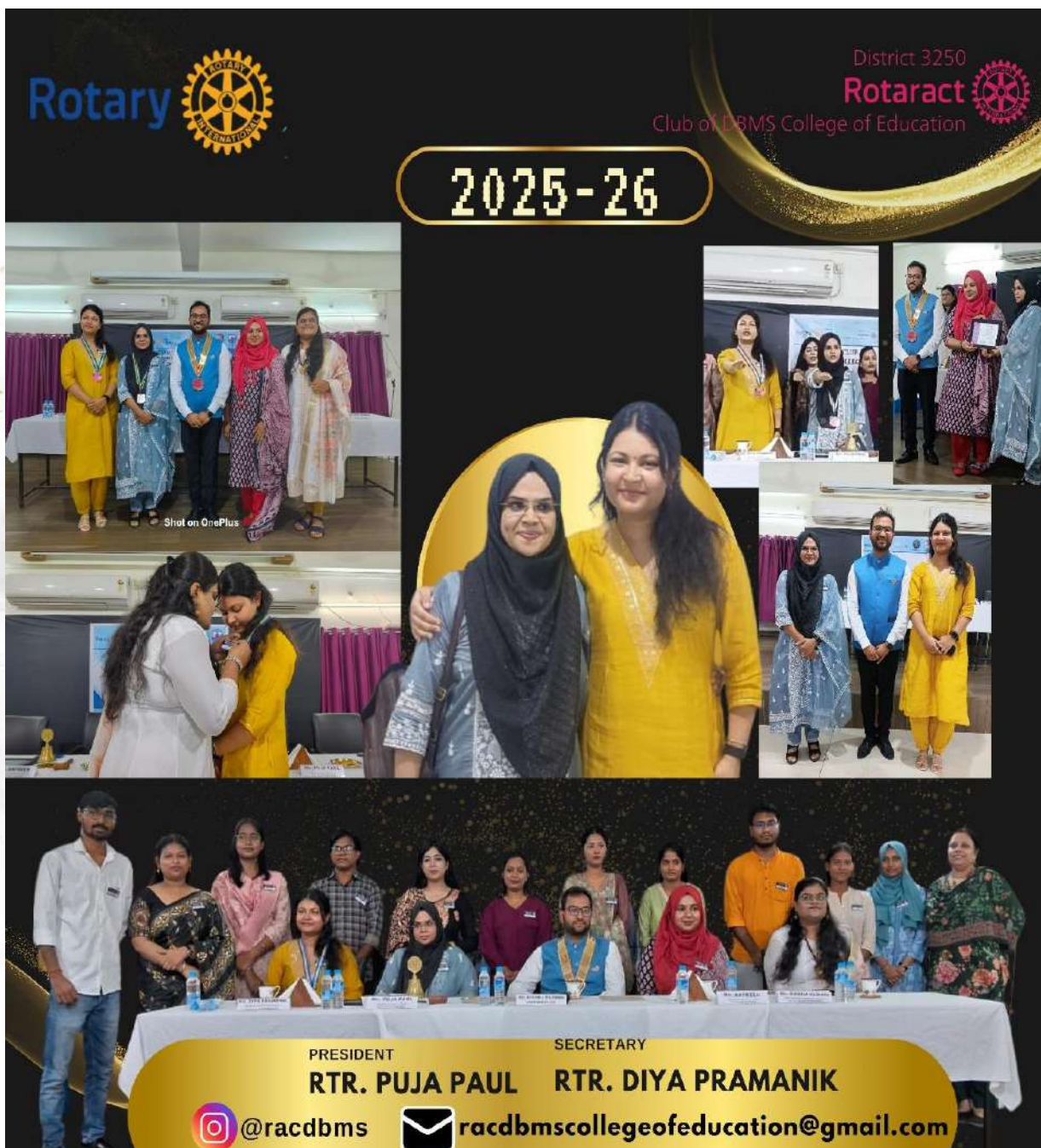

An awareness session on **Maternal and Child Health** was conducted on 28.07.2025 at D.B.M.S. Lilliput School Domuhani, Sonari, targeting underprivileged school students and mothers in the local community. The session was conducted by the Rotaract Club of D.B.M.S. College of Education aimed to educate participants on essential health practices, nutrition, hygiene, immunization, and the importance of antenatal and postnatal care. The primary objectives of the session were:

- To raise awareness about the importance of maternal and child health.
- To educate mothers and students on proper nutrition, hygiene, and preventive healthcare.
- To reduce myths and misconceptions related to pregnancy and child-rearing practices.
- To promote institutional deliveries and immunization coverage.

A short talk was given on maternal nutrition, importance of antenatal check-ups, breastfeeding, and infant care. Charts were used to explain the stages of pregnancy, nutrition requirements, and growth milestones of children. An open forum was held for the participants to ask questions, clarify doubts, and share their experiences.

133 beneficiaries receive HPV vaccine in DBMS cervical cancer drive

Jamshedpur, Sep 1: DBMS Trust, in collaboration with Meherbai Tata Memorial Hospital (MTMH), the Rotaract Club of DBMS College, and Rotary, organized a cervical cancer vaccination drive on August 30.
