CIVIL DEFENCE MOCK DRILL REPORT

Date: 07-05-2025

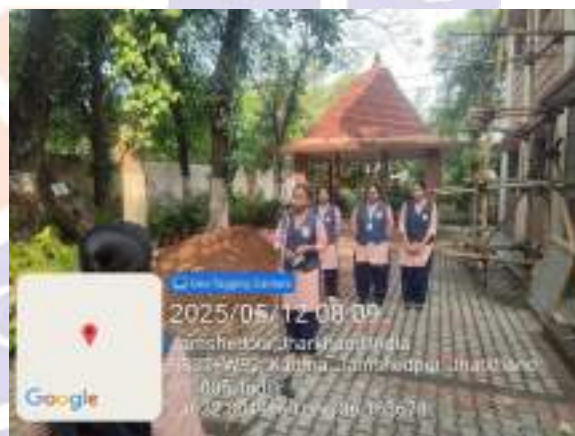
On May 7, 2025, NSS Unit 1 of D.B.M.S. College of Education organized a Civil Defence Mock Drill to strengthen emergency preparedness and response protocols. The programme began with the screening of a government video to educate students about safety measures during emergencies. Students were informed about exit routes and the designated assembly point, Classroom 1 (Ground Floor), and were guided on precautions to be taken during an air raid. A mock air raid scenario was conducted, during which students practiced safety measures such as drawing curtains, switching off lights, remaining calm, and following instructions carefully. After the drill, participants safely reassembled in their respective classrooms, and a running notice was displayed on the college website. The drill successfully enhanced awareness, coordination, and understanding of civil defence procedures among faculty, staff, and students, ensuring better preparedness for emergency situations.



EMERGENCY AWARENESS SESSION UNDER “OPERATION SINDOOR”

Date: 12/05/2025

NSS Unit 1 of D.B.M.S. College of Education conducted an Emergency Awareness Session in the context of “Operation Sindoor,” a military operation carried out by the Indian Armed Forces in response to a terrorist attack in Pahalgam. The session aimed to inform students about the prevailing geopolitical situation and educate them on emergency preparedness during air raids, bomb threats, or wartime disruptions. The programme began with an address by the NSS Programme Officer emphasizing safety and national awareness, followed by a government-circulated video and a brief introduction explaining the background and civilian implications of the operation, named “Sindoor” by Narendra Modi to symbolize the protection of national honour and citizens. Students were trained in precautionary measures such as drawing curtains, switching off lights, hiding under desks, responding to sirens, and proceeding to the designated assembly point (Room No. 1, Ground Floor) along with faculty and staff. A detailed session on Do’s and Don’ts during air raids was conducted using visuals, and assembly points were clearly marked by the college safety committee. The session significantly enhanced students’ alertness, discipline, civic responsibility, and overall campus preparedness, reinforcing unity and awareness as essential elements of national resilience during emergencies.



DENTAL CHECK-UP CAMP 2025

Date: 08-05-2025

Venue: D.B.M.S. Girls High School

The NSS Unit I of D.B.M.S. College of Education organized a Dental Check-Up Camp on 08 May 2025 at D.B.M.S. Girls High School for students of Classes VI to IX. The camp was conducted under the supervision of the Programme Officer and the IQAC Coordinator, along with dedicated NSS volunteers who ensured its smooth execution. The resource person, Dr. Anish Kumar Srivastava, conducted free dental examinations and provided essential guidance on maintaining proper oral hygiene. Students received individual consultations along with treatment recommendations based on their dental health conditions. A total of 195 students benefited from the camp, which successfully promoted oral health awareness and emphasized the importance of early detection and preventive dental care.



EYE CHECK-UP CAMP

VENUE: COMMUNITY HALL, FARM AREA (NEAR DURGA PUJA MAIDAN)

Date: 13-05-2025

An Eye Check-Up Camp was organized on 13 May 2025 by NSS Unit I of D.B.M.S. College of Education in collaboration with the Lions Club of Jamshedpur, under the supervision of an eye specialist from ASG Hospital. Conducted at the Community Hall in the Farm Area near Durga Puja Maidan, the camp aimed to provide free eye consultations, identify early signs of vision-related issues, and spread awareness about eye health and hygiene. The specialist carried out individual screenings to check visual acuity, refractive errors, and other common eye conditions, while also offering guidance on preventive care and healthy lifestyle practices. A large number of local residents attended the camp, and several cases requiring further treatment were identified and referred. The initiative successfully promoted eye health awareness, strengthened community engagement, and reinforced the spirit of social responsibility among volunteers and participants.
