### **INTRODUCTION**

On 20th March 2026, an awareness session on Postal Services in India was organised by IQAC of D.B.M.S. College of Education. Officials from Bistupur branch Indian Post Office visited the institution and conducted an informative and interactive session for the students. The session highlighted how the post office has evolved from a simple mail delivery system into a comprehensive service provider, offering financial, insurance, postal, and digital services. The programme aimed to create awareness about the practical utility of government services available through the post office.

### **OBJECTIVE**

- Educate students about the wide range of services provided by the Indian Post Office.
- Create awareness about financial schemes, insurance services, and government facilities available at the doorstep.
- Help students understand the practical use of these services in daily life.
- Encourage responsible use of government schemes and digital services.

### **PROCESS**

The session began with an introduction to the postal services, including postcards, field post, mail, and courier services. Mr. Nishant Kumar explained the historical significance of the post office, mentioning that the first General Post Office (GPO) was established in Kolkata in 1774, and Mumbai's GPO in

1913. He also highlighted important aspects such as the Highest Claim Post, the 3D Post Office, and the celebration of Postal Worker Day on 1st July.

Mr.Ujjwal Kesari then elaborated on various financial and insurance services provided by the post office. They explained schemes such as:

- Sukanya Samriddhi Yojana for girls' education and savings
- Public Provident Fund (PPF) as a safe investment option
- Senior Citizen Savings Scheme with 8.2% interest
- Monthly Income Scheme (MIS) with 7.4% interest
- Kisan Vikas Patra (KVP) with 7.5% interest

They also discussed Postal Life Insurance (PLI), introduced in 1894, which provides life insurance benefits, especially for women. Further, the session focused on government utility and digital services, including assistance in bill payments, PAN card, passport, and Aadhaar services. Practical demonstrations were given on AEPS withdrawals, DBT withdrawals, Aadhaar enrolment, and Digital Life Certificate services. The officials emphasised the concept of "Every Service at Your Doorstep," highlighting the role of post offices in making services accessible to all citizens.

The session was highly interactive, with students actively asking questions about various schemes, interest rates, and procedures. The officials clarified all queries, making the session engaging and informative.

## **OUTCOME**

The session proved to be highly beneficial for the students. They gained a clear understanding that post offices are not limited to mail delivery, but also provide financial security, insurance, and essential government services. Students became aware of different saving schemes and investment options suitable for various sections of society.

## Postal services awareness session held at DBMS College

**Jamshedpur, March 20:** An awareness session on postal services was organized by the Department of Posts at DBMS College of Education on Friday, providing students with insights into various schemes and facilities offered by India Post.

Officials from Bistupur Post Office, Nishant Kumar and Ujjwal Kesari, addressed the session and informed students about the wide network of 1,64,983 post offices across the country. They also shared that the postal service was opened to the public in March 1774 during the tenure of Warren Hastings, the then Governor-General of British India.



The speakers highlighted that post offices are spread across the nation, from Kashmir to Kanyakumari, covering even remote rural and aquatic regions. They explained how postal services have evolved over time, becoming more modern and accessible. Facilities such as online Speed Post, ATM services, and online account opening are now available to customers. The officials also dis-

cussed various schemes designed for girls, women, students, and senior citizens, noting that senior citizens receive higher interest rates compared to banks. They added that insurance services for women, which were not available before 1995, have since been introduced, especially in rural areas.

Earlier, the programme began with a welcome address by Principal Dr. Joohi Samarpita, while B.Ed. student Pragya Priyadarshini delivered the vote of thanks. Secretary Priya Dharmarajan, Joint Secretary Sudhakar Dilip, Vice-Principal Dr. Monika Uppal, faculty members, and students were present. The session was interactive, with students actively participating and raising queries. (W-mb)
