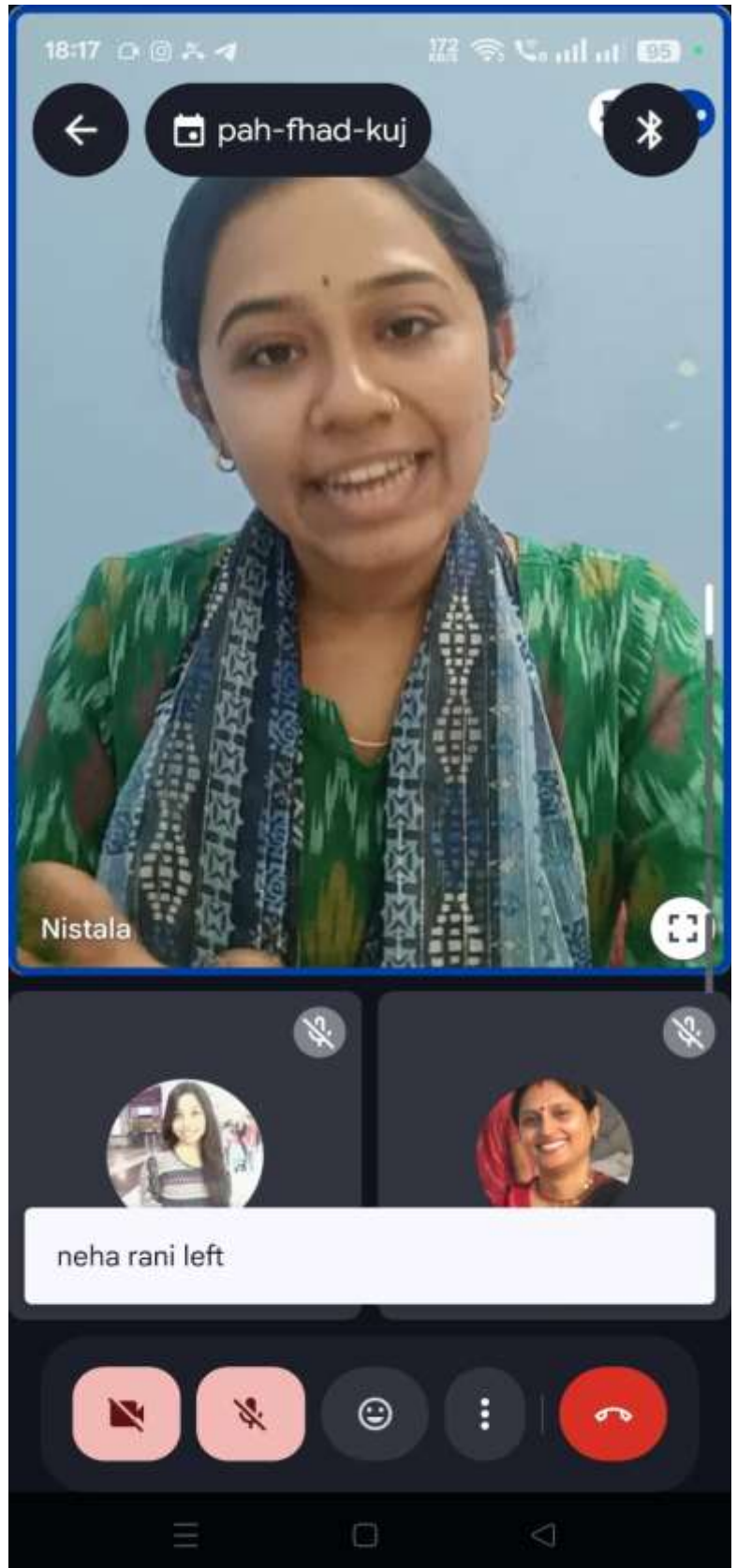
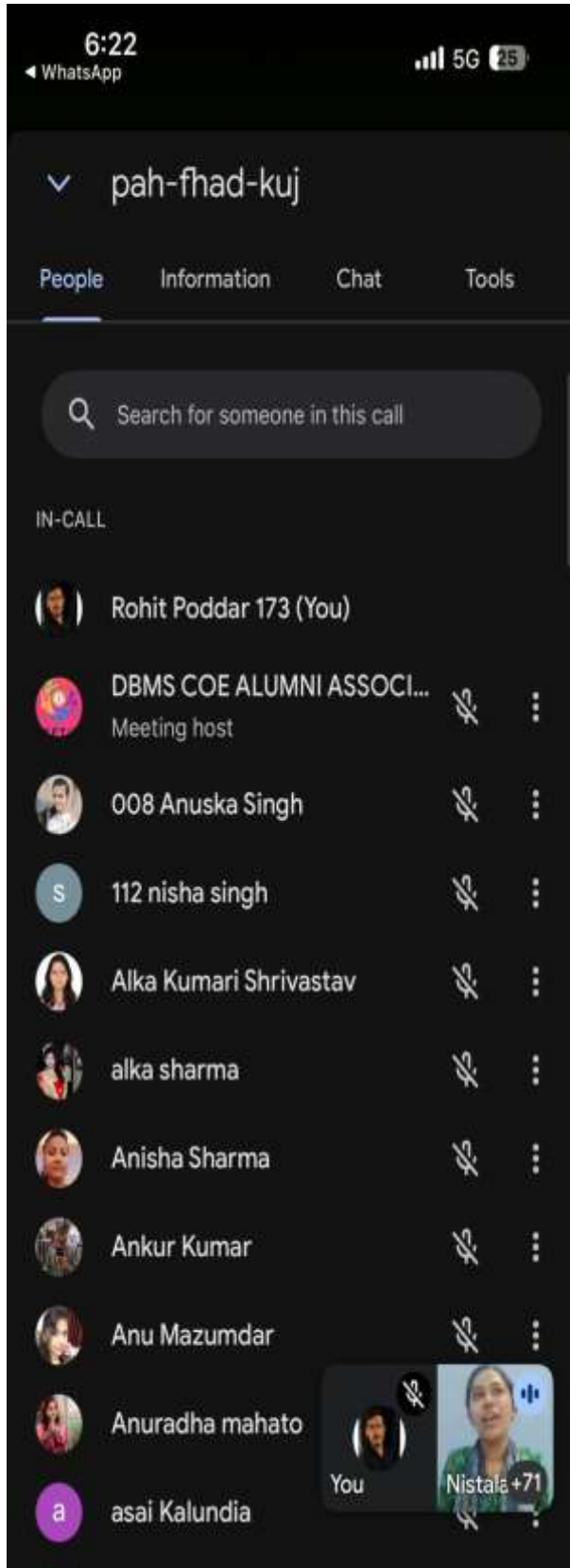
EXPERIENCE OF NEW TEACHER.

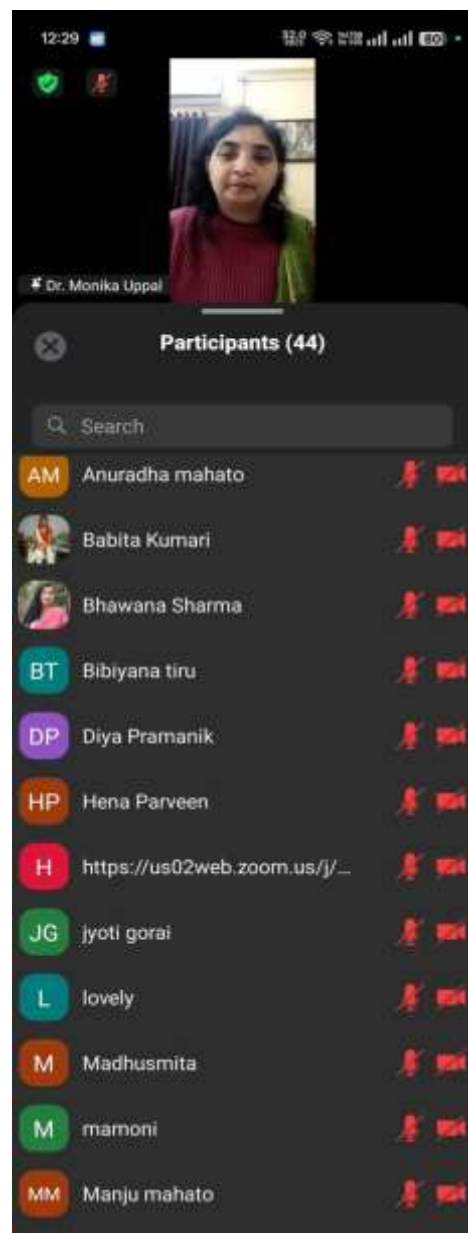

PRE PLACEMENT SESSION

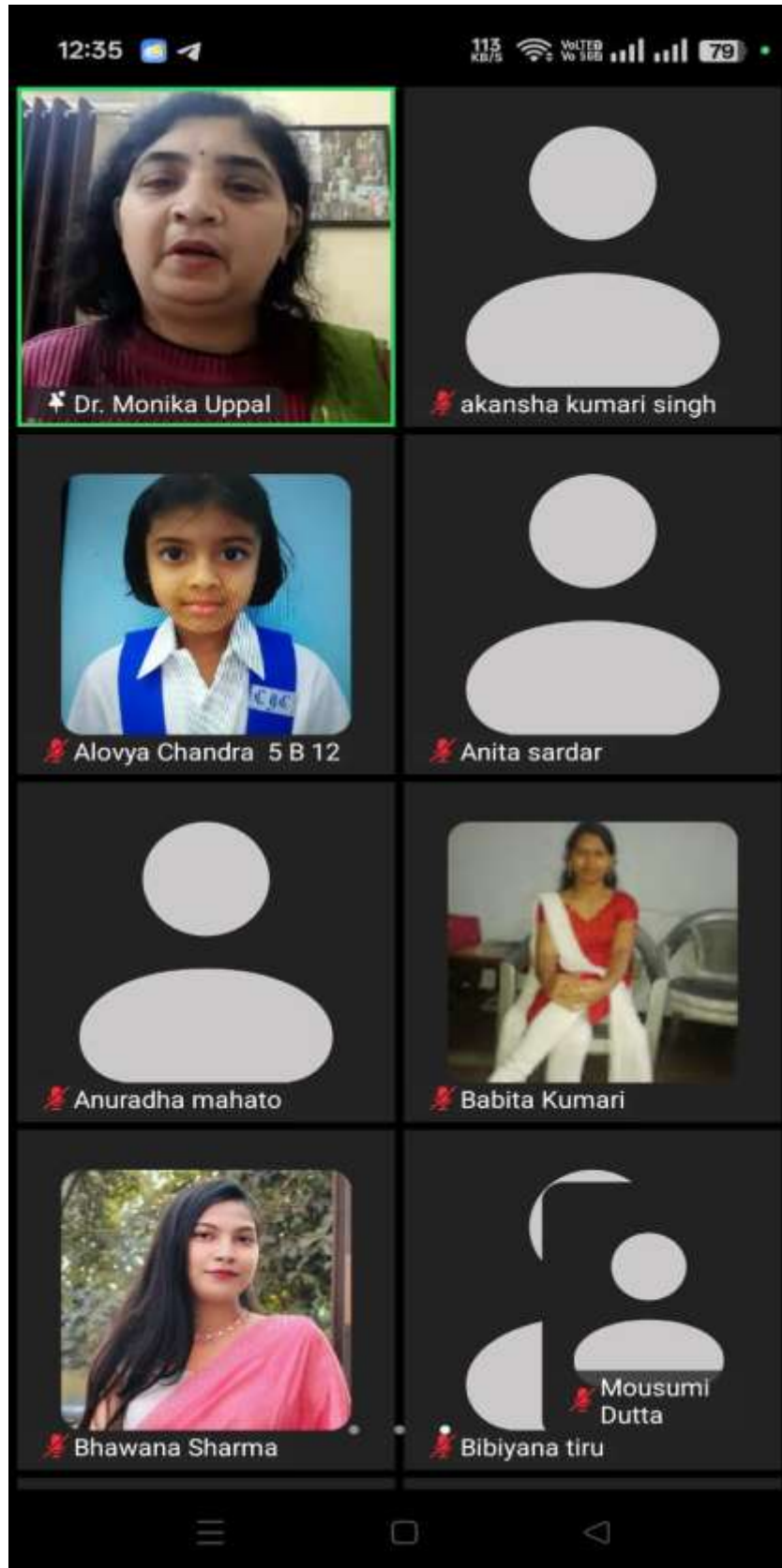
